HOSA CERT Competition

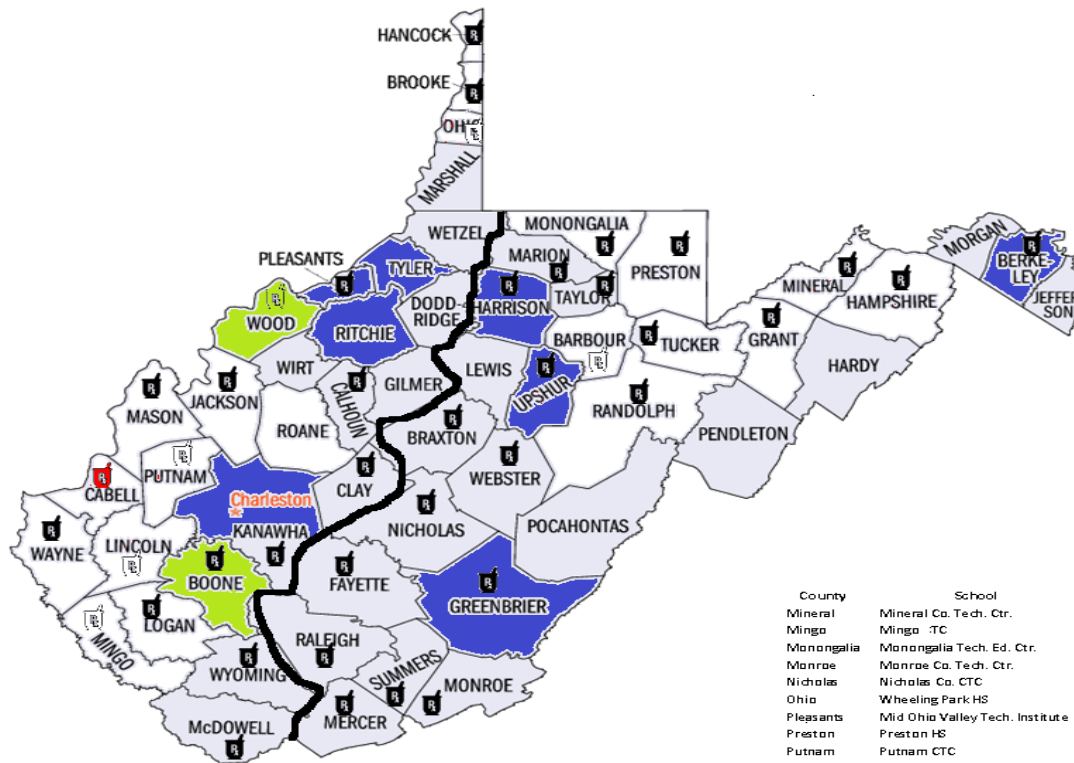
- Written Test Plan
