



## Emergency Kit Contents

- Cell phone with chargers and backup battery
- Radio: crank, battery or solar powered
- Flashlight & batteries
- First Aid Kit
- Wrench/Pliers (to turn off utilities)
- Local maps
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape (to shelter in place)
- Medical information, insurance cards, bank account records
- Paper towels, moist wipes, garbage bags & ties
- Cash, checkbook
- Can opener
- Whistle
- Dust Facemask (to filter contaminated air)

## Have at least a 3-day or more supply of:

- Non-perishable food
- Water: 1-gallon per person per day
- Medications & medical equipment
- Pet supplies: food, water, collar, carrier, toys, etc.

**Check your kit supplies once a year to replace expired food, batteries, or used items.**
