



Emergency Kit Contents

- ☐ Cell phone with chargers and backup battery
- ☐ Radio: crank, battery or solar powered
- ☐ Flashlight & batteries
- ☐ First Aid Kit
- ☐ Wrench/Pliers (to turn off utilities)
- ☐ Local maps
- ☐ Plastic sheeting and duct tape (to shelter in place)
- ☐ Medical information, insurance cards, bank account records
- ☐ Paper towels, moist wipes, garbage bags & ties
- ☐ Cash, checkbook
- ☐ Can opener
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Dust Facemask (to filter contaminated air)

Have at least a 3-day or more supply of:

- ☐ Non-perishable food
- ☐ Water: 1-gallon per person per day
- ☐ Medications & medical equipment
- ☐ Pet supplies: food, water, collar, carrier, toys, etc.

Check your kit supplies once a year to replace expired food, batteries, or used items.
